Notice of Race

The Organising Authority is the **Highcliffe Sailing Club**

1. Rules

1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing , The RS Standard Sailing Instructions 2011 as set out on the RS Association website, www.rs-association.com . The local sailing instructions appendix for this event available at registration . and this notice of race

Local instructions

All boats will launch from Gundimore beach into Christchurch

All boats will be tallied , tally station adjacent to beach ,

Mainsails are not to be raised when trolleying between boat park on green and beach Boats must not be rigged on carpark - to be on the green

Cars not permitted on the green

2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1. Entries shall be made on the official entry form available from the Club office

3.2. All entrants must be members of the RS Class Association .

3.2. All boats shall hold adequate insurance and in particular hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2.0 million.

4.2. Registration from 10:00hrs on Saturday 11th June & Sunday 5th June

4.3. There will be a competitor briefing at 11:00hrs on Saturday 11th June in the main hall

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The local sailing instructions for each event will normally be available at the Club and on the Club website one week before the first race of the event.

6. Venue and Course Area

6.1. The venue will be the Highcliffe Sailing Club Mundeford Quay Christchurch

6.2. The course area will be within Christchurch bay East of transit of Hengistbury Head and the Needles

7. Courses

7.1. Courses will be: Windward/ Leeward or Trapezoid

8. Scoring

8.1. The minimum number of races to constitute a series is 2.

8.2. The number of counted races and excluded races will be as follows:

Up to and including 4 races completed all races to be counted to determine a boats score

5 races or more races completed all races less one discard to be counted to determine a boats score

10. Prizes

10.1. Prizes will be 1st , 2nd 3rd in each class .

11. Safety and Disclaimer

11.1. The race organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.

11.2. A boat that retires from a race shall make every effort to inform the Race Committee as soon as practical

12. Support Boats

12.1. Support boats may be subject to restrictions that will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

12. Amendments to the Notice of Race

12.1. This notice of race may be changed by a notice posted on the official notice board (and duplicated on the Club website).
